**Please note**: although we are getting into a stronger position, we cannot put absolute emphasis on, nor can we draw absolute conclusions from, the data in these school reports because we are still not entirely certain how many valid and reliable questions each Year 4 student received in our third run through the online RE assessment process ... but we are in a stronger position than we were in our first run through in 2015!

## (2) Remember

We are seeking to add to the evidence base from which teachers and schools might reflect upon the impact their teaching practice has had on their student's learning over a four-year period.

Our research/professional learning project seeks to create a culture of trust, to use the power and wisdom of teacher expertise in the question writing process supported by the power and capacity of cloud-based computer technology to enable us to better answer the questions about what students know and what the appropriate next steps might be for our individual and collective teaching practice.
